


Our school will improve student outcomes by

Employ staff to develop and implement structured Pre-Prep engagement programs and provide additional support for research-based phonological awareness and reading intervention programs.	\$ 175 500
Actions – Initiative 2	Costs
Utilise a range of strategies including: coaching, mentoring, and feedback to teachers through formal observations and feedback and watching others work – to support all staff to implement high quality teaching and learning practices.	\$ 454 178
Actions – Initiative 3	Costs
Implement and lead a support structure for PBL to support the targeted needs of students.	\$ 200 000
Actions – Initiative 4	Costs
Employ para-professionals to work with school leaders and teaching staff to engage with community groups.	\$ 75 000
